Fr. Leonard L. Marrujo is the current Parochial Administrator, (Pastor) of Assumption Parish. Before entering the priesthood Fr. Leonard was a graphic designer and technical illustrator for SUNMicrosystems and numerous design and tech firms in the San Francisco bay area and Silicon Valley. He entered the seminary at St. Patrick's Seminary in 2006 and was ordained in 2013 for the diocese of Oakland. He has a Bachelor of Arts in design, Masters of Divinity and a degree in Sacred Theology (STD). Upon his ordination he was assigned to the Catholic Community of Pleasanton.

Sister Jennifer Tecla Hyatt, FSP, is a member of the Daughters of St Paul, a religious community dedicated to evangelization with the media. She has a BA in Theology and is a Master Catechist in the Archdiocese of Los Angeles. Jennifer is currently an associate of the Pauline Center for Media Studies stationed in Redwood City, CA. Over the past three years, Sister has facilitated various film and Scripture activities for both children and adults, as well as given presentations on media literacy and integrating culture, faith and media.
